Scholarship Information

This scholarship is offered to Mesquite ISD seniors who are planning to pursue an undergraduate degree in a medical-health related field. The degrees cannot be on the administrative side of healthcare, but on the side of direct patient care. (Pre-med, Pre- dentistry, physical therapy and speech therapy/pathology, audiology, optometry, podiatry, chiropractic, and nursing, to name most of them) This scholarship will be awarded annually to three graduating seniors.

Scholarship Amount: \$9000, payable at the rate of \$1500 per year for the 1st and 2nd years, and \$3000 per year for the 3rd and 4th year. To renew the scholarship annually, evidence of successful completion of course work and a tentative schedule or degree plan will be required. The student must also remain in the medical-health related degree program like those stated above.
